### Course Aims

By the end of the course, students will be able to:

Describe someone's appearance.

Talk about their age, profession, and telephone number.

Discuss their interests and hobbies in Polish.

Use the cases *Biernik* (accusative) and *Dopełniacz* (genitive) in sentences.

Form and ask more complex questions and express their opinions with more grammatical accuracy.

The course is focused on communication, practical tasks, and includes listening, reading, speaking, and some writing practice.

### Learning Objectives

#### Topics / Vocabulary / Grammar

##### 1. Describing Someone's Appearance

Learn vocabulary and phrases for describing someone's physical traits.

Use adjectives to describe hair, eyes, and general appearance.

Practice using verbs like *mieć* (to have), *być* (to be) in the present tense.

##### 2. Giving Your Age

Learn how to state your age in Polish using forms of *rok* (year) and *lat/ lata* .

Form questions about age (e.g., Ile masz lat? - How old are you?).

### 3. Saying What Your Profession Is

Learn vocabulary for professions (e.g., nauczyciel, lekarka, kucharz).( intro to Instrumental case )

Discuss your occupation and ask others about theirs.

Use the verb być to talk about professions.

### 4. Talking About Your Interests

Discuss hobbies, leisure activities, and interests in Polish.

Learn how to express interest using the verb interesować się (to be interested in).

Practice asking questions like Czym się interesujesz? (What are you interested in?).

### 5. Numbers 0-100/ also counting in tens

Learn numbers from 0 to 100 for talking about age, telephone numbers, and other common numeric expressions.

Practice saying numbers in context (e.g., telephone numbers, addresses).

### 6. Polish Traditions

Learn about some Polish traditions. Understand key cultural practices and vocabulary related to these holidays.
