Course Aims

This course helps learners build a solid foundation in beginner Korean so they can confidently use the language in everyday situations. Students will learn to read and write Hangeul (Korean writing system), use practical vocabulary, and understand key grammar points such as sentence endings, particles, and basic verb forms. They will practice introducing themselves, talking about their country and job, asking for and giving phone numbers with Sino-Korean numbers, and describing objects and their locations using common expressions. By the end of the course, learners will be able to create simple sentences, talk about daily activities, and use essential structures like negation and present-tense verb endings to communicate clearly in Korean.
